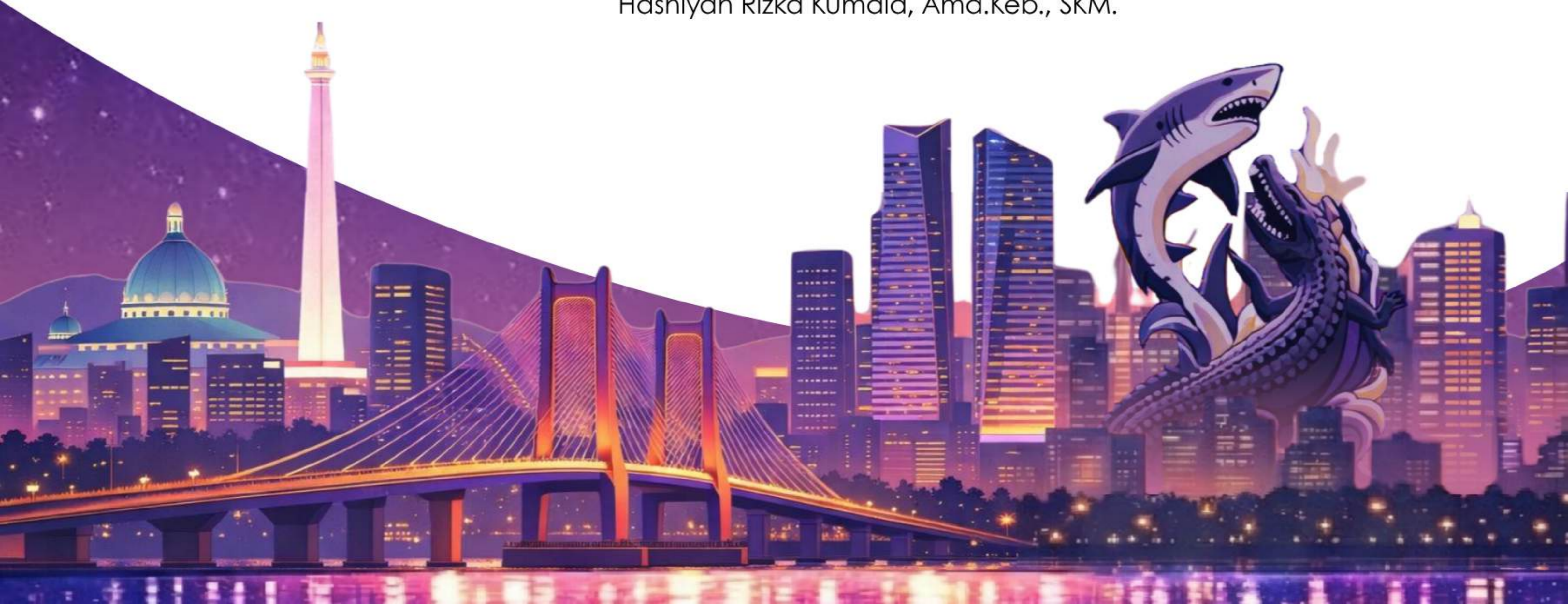

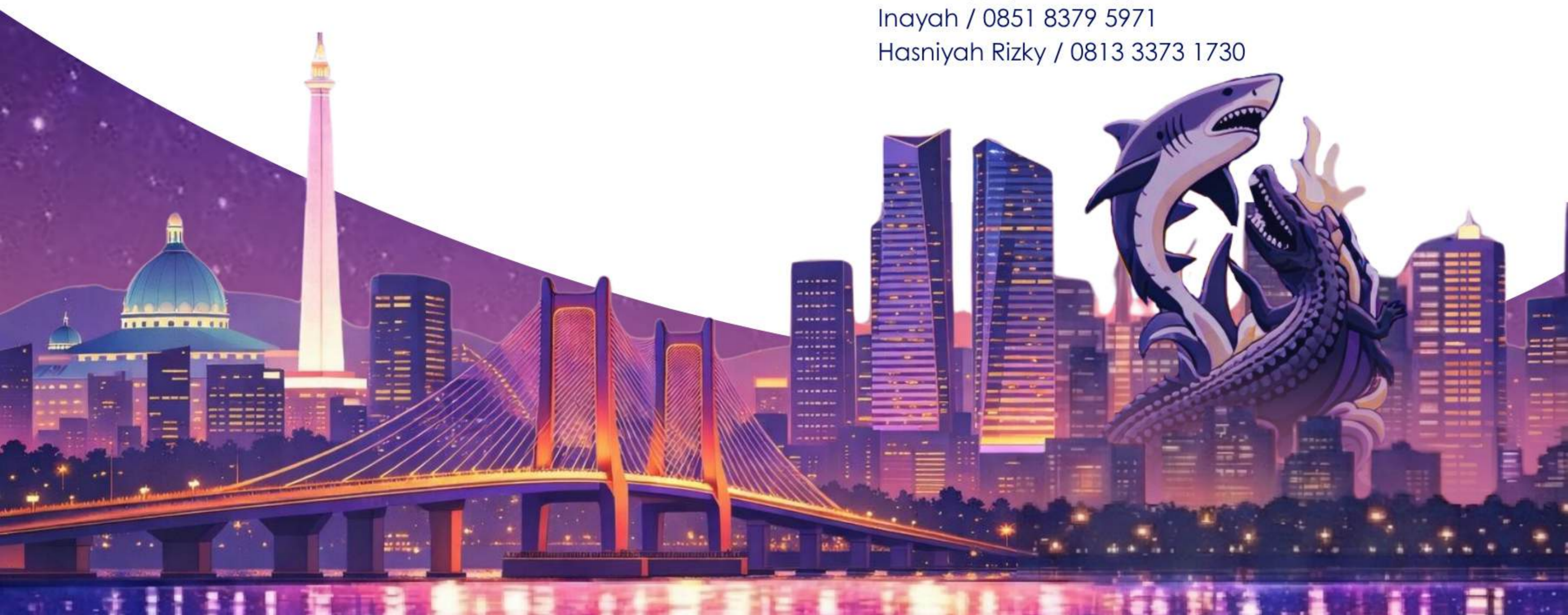

- Each abstract may include a maximum of 30 authors.
- Authors are permitted to include one (1) figure or one (1) table within the abstract.
- If an author holds dual affiliation with both a hospital and a university, please state the name of the hospital where he/she is currently practicing.
- The abstract must not exceed 250 words.
- All abstracts submitted for the competition will undergo peer review by the Scientific Committee.
- All participants are required to prepare an e-Poster. The e-Poster does not need to be submitted at the time of abstract submission. The e-Poster should be sent to iibcsurabaya@gmail.com before April 30th 2026 at 24:00 (midnight, local time). Late submissions will not be considered.
- Following the evaluation process, the Scientific Committee will select the five (5) highest-scoring abstracts, and the selected authors will be invited to deliver a Podium Presentation at the conference.

E-Poster Requirements

- All abstract presenters are required to prepare an E-Poster with the following specifications:
 - a. The E-Poster must be submitted in PDF format, with a maximum file size of 10 MB.

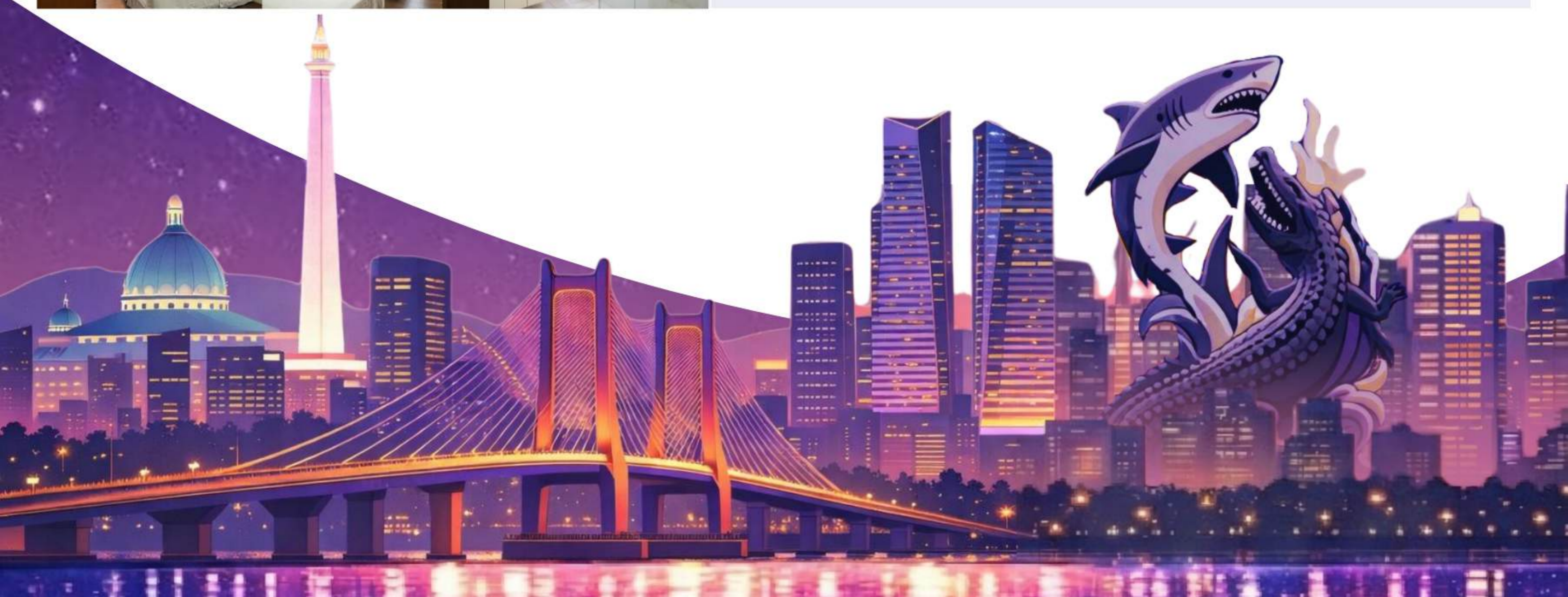
